Aurora State Airport Master Plan Update – Kick-Off Meeting

Date: *November 3, 2009*
Time: *6:00 pm – 7:30 pm*

The intent of the project is to update the 2000 Aurora State Airport Master Plan. This document is nine years old and needs to reflect new facilities, current projections of airport activity, new environmental and other regulatory constraints, and plan for an appropriate mix of land uses to support projected aviation and non-aviation needs and the long-term financial health of the airport.

The updated Master Plan will help the Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) determine needed airside and landside improvements based on updated forecasts of demand for aviation services. Obsolete elements of the existing airport layout plan will be corrected and an updated capital improvement plan will allow ODA to make strategic investments in needed airfield projects.

ODA is developing a Planning Advisory Committee, which will be a major component of the public involvement process. ODA will rely on the input of the Planning Advisory Committee to help develop the Master Plan. Several of the Planning Advisory Committee positions are open for at large representatives, serving Marion County, Clackamas County, City of Aurora and City of Wilsonville. If you are interested in serving as an at-large representative on the Planning Advisory Committee, information and an application will be available at the kick-off meeting.
